

Field Striping and Maintenance Specialist Job Description

Position Title: Field Striping and Maintenance Specialist

Position Type: Seasonal (Fall and Spring, 10-12 weeks per season)

Position Summary

The Field Striping and Maintenance Specialist is responsible for the accurate layout, marking, and upkeep of sports fields, ensuring they meet standards. The position involves collaboration with local parks departments, maintenance of striping equipment, and efficient organization of supplies and resources. This role plays a vital part in supporting the sports program by providing well-maintained and accurately marked fields.

Key Responsibilities

1. **Field Preparation and Striping**
 - Measure, string line, and construct soccer fields to precise dimensions.
 - Stripe fields weekly over the 10-12 week seasons in both Fall and Spring.
 - Measure and mark field corners at the end of the season for future setup using small amounts of herbicide (e.g., Round-Up).
2. **Resource Management**
 - Order, pick up, and arrange delivery of paint and other field-marking supplies.
 - Coordinate CO2 cylinder exchanges and pick-ups with Crookham Company, ensuring all paint is thoroughly cleaned off returned cylinders to maintain donor goodwill.
3. **Equipment Maintenance**
 - Oversee golf cart repairs and maintenance, including ensuring distilled water in batteries is at appropriate levels.
 - Perform minor maintenance on the field striper, such as replacing hoses, valves, and tires.
4. **Collaboration and Communication**
 - Maintain a direct line of communication with the Parks Department regarding field upkeep, maintenance, and watering schedules.
 - Report field or equipment issues promptly to appropriate personnel and coordinate resolutions.
5. **Additional Duties**
 - Uphold safety standards while performing tasks and operating equipment.
 - Track and manage inventory of supplies and tools.
 - Assist with other field-related tasks as assigned.

- Prior experience in sports field marking, maintenance, or similar roles.
- Basic mechanical knowledge for equipment upkeep.

Work Schedule

- Flexible hours during the Fall and Spring seasons, typically aligning with the program schedule and weather conditions.
